History of Migration Film in Germany

1960's:

-outkasts and minorities are presented in films of German's (Fassbinder: "Angst essen Seele auf"

1970's

-sponsorship of "migration films" by public television

-first experimental films with ethnic minorities:

sorrowful tories migrants lost between cultures stereotypes and clichés

1980's

- -polarization of cultures
- -women are presented as oppressed by their fathers, men and husband
- -no meeting/interaction between cultures

OR

- -Turkish women saved by German men from dependence, suppression, imprisonment (Hark Bohm: "Yasemin")
- -polarization continues

German society as superior Germans feel pity for "victims" (migrants) migrants, especially "turks" are seen as closed, homogeneous, coexisting, society
