Race and Racism

- the concept of Race is linked to
 - ancestry
 - genetics/ phenology
 - physical difference
 - colour
- according to the biological definition of races, there is only one human race
- believing in different human races is the basis of the ideology racism



Racism and other concepts

- Major examples of racism
 - against Blacks in the USA
 - against Jews in Germany
- Racism is linked for example to
 - Xenophobia
 - Islamophobia
 - Sexism
 - Homophobia



Race and virtual ethnicity

- ethnic groups are defining themselves
 - in distinction to others
 - with reference to shared history
 - often claiming to be superior
- at the basis there can be racism
 - as origin of the ethnic group
 - as reaction to marginalisation
- internet can be used to propagate or legitimise discrimination



Kolko et al

- 5: „all of us who spend time online are already shaped by the ways in which race matters offline,
- and we can't help but bring our own knowledge, experiences, and values with us when we log on.“
