### Race and Racism

- the concept of Race is linked to
  - ancestry
  - genetics/ phenology
  - physical difference
  - colour
- according to the biological definition of races, there is only one human race
- believing in different human races is the basis of the ideology racism

  - Homophobia



### Race and virtual ethnicity

- ethnic groups are defining themselves
  - in distinction to others
  - with reference to shared history
  - often claiming to be superior
- at the basis there can be racism
  - as origin of the ethnic group
  - as reaction to marginalisation
- internet can be used to propagate or legitimise discrimination



#### Kolko et al
