Diaspora

- attempt of a description:
- example:
 - Protestants in the diaspora (in the Sauerland)
- belonging to a collective scattered across different places
- living in an environment where another collective is in the majority
- often used in literature like this



Saffran's and Clifford's views on diaspora in comparison

- Saffran focuses his definition on
 - a home country
- Clifford focuses on
 - the connections in the diaspora
 - he stresses routes rather than roots
 - transnationalism rather than nationalism



Clifford's diaspora

"... understood as a practice of dwelling (differently),

as an ambivalent refusal or indefinite deferral of return,

and as a positive transnationalism ... "Clifford (1994, 321)



Observation

- Any problems, questions, remarks on your observations?
 - transactional ethnicity is a proces, which always works
 - diaspora describes a collective, which in cases applies
 - give thick description
 - discuss theory on basis of observation
 - make description, raise questions instead of judging and giving answers
 - in dealing with questionnaires be careful about the validity of the statistics



Hybridity in my research

- wanted to give you example of youth seminar
- of Indians of the second generation,
 German-Indians, Indo-Germans, Desis, ...
- wanted to combine participant observation and interviews
- but seminar had to be cancelled



Concept of hybridity

- developed by Homi Bhaba, Stuart Hall, Paul Gilroy (Black Atlantic)
- something new developing from colonial encounter
