Virtual Ethnicity

- new media providing new social spaces
- used by members of ethnic minorities
- topic:
 - Ethnic identity construction in the internet

- compare also with:
 - imagined communities (Anderson)
 - development of nationalism



Methods

- combination of theoretical and empirical approach
- one of many approaches to the topic
- learn empirical research
- learn to critically deal with academic texts and approaches
- not: learning the truth
- but: learning academic approach
